



KANSAS CITY, Mo. - The Strive is set to join Metro Station and Palaye Royale on this fall's Savior Tour.

The Savior Tour will coincide with the release of the Kansas City-based modern rock band's album *Modern Pace*, out October 14.

"We are stoked to be touring with Metro Station and Palaye Royale," said bassist Michael Zenk.
